IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Recording Certificates of Decree Barring Husband or Wife of Rights in Real Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section sixteen of chapter sixty-six of the revised stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the words "in the 3 same county" in the fifth line of said section, and by in-4 serting in place thereof the words "in the county or coun-5 ties where real estate which may be affected by such decree 6 is situated," so that said section as amended shall read as 7 follows:

'Sect. 16. Certified copies of decree to be filed in offices 2 of registers and deeds and recorded. Whenever any de-

3 cree provided for in sections ten and eleven hereof shall 4 become effective either by reason of expiration of the time 5 within which an appeal might have been taken or if final 6 judgment on appeal, the register of probate, shall forth-7 with file in the office of the register of deeds in the county 8 or counties where real estate which may be affected by such 9 decree is situated, under seal of the probate court, a cer-10 tificated copy thereof which the register of deeds shall 11 record without fee.'
