STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Jackman-Rockwood Road.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the fiscal year
3 ending in nineteen hundred thirty and the sum of twenty-
4 five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending in nineteen
5 hundred thirty-one, to aid in the construction of the high-
6 way leading from Jackman to Rockwood, upon the con-
7 dition however, that, from other sources the sum of ten
8 thousand dollars be paid into the treasury of the state dur-
9 ing the year nineteen hundred twenty-nine or nineteen hun-
10 dred thirty and an additional sum of ten thousand dollars

11 be likewise paid into the treasury of the state during the
12 year nineteen hundred thirty or nineteen hundred thirty-
13 one for the same purpose. The expenditure of said sums
14 of money shall be under the supervision of the state high-
15 way commission and the type of construction shall be such
16 as may be determined by a joint board consisting of the
17 members of the state highway commission and the county
18 commissioners of Somerset county.
