AN ACT to Amend Section Seven of Chapter Sixty-five of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Order of Court Prohibiting Restraint of Wife Pending Libel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seven of chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and 3 by substituting in place thereof the following:

‘Sect. 7. *Court may free wife from restraint pending 2 libel.* Pending a libel, the court, or any justice thereof in 3 vacation, on petition of the wife, may prohibit the husband 4 from imposing any restraint on her personal liberty; and 5 enforce obedience by appropriate processes.’
