STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred and Forty-six of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended, Relative to Appropriation for Normal and Training Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred and forty-six of chapter sixteen of
2 the revised statutes as amended by chapter sixty-four of
3 the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen, as
4 amended by chapter one hundred forty-nine of the public
5 laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended by
6 chapter forty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred
7 and twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out all of
8 said section as amended and by inserting in place thereof
9 the following section:

'Sect. 146. *Appropriation for normal and training schools.*

2 For the maintenance, upkeep, and extension of the normal
3 schools and the Madawaska Training school, the state treas-
4 urer shall deduct annually from the state school fund such
5 sums as the legislature may direct, the same to be expended
6 by the board of trustees for such institutions.'
