STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Nineteen of Chapter One Hundred Forty-eight of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Penalty for Making False Affidavit of Application for Pension for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section nineteen of chapter one hundred and forty-eight

of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out

the words "be deemed guilty of perjury and shall be sub
ject to the penalty provided by law therefor" and by insert
ing in place thereof the words: 'be punished by a fine of

not more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment not

exceeding eleven months, or both,' so that said section as

8 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 19. Penalty for making false affidavit. Whoever 2 makes a false affidavit in order to secure the benefit herein 3 provided, shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of 4 not more than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment not 5 exceeding eleven months, or both.'
