STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" TO

AN ACT Relating to the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

Strike out all of said act subsequent to the enacting clause, 2 and insert in place thereof the following:

- 'No person shall sell any substance which when com-
- 2 pressed produces a liquid containing more than one-half
- 3 of one per cent of alcohol with a knowledge or having
- 4 reasonable cause to believe that the same is to be so com-
- 5 pressed and the liquid so produced used as a beverage.
- 6 Any person violating the provision of this act shall be pun-
- 7 ished by a fine not less than three hundred dollars nor more
- 8 than five hundred dollars and by imprisonment not less
- 9 than three months nor more than six months.'
