STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Municipal Court
Recorder of Sanford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter thirty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred fifteen as amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in the third line thereof the word "four" and inserting in place thereof the word 'eight,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. The recorder of the Sanford municipal court shall receive as compensation an annual salary of eight hundred dollars, payable quarterly, on the first days of

4 January, April, July and October, from the county treasury
5 of the county of York. All fees received by him shall be
6 paid over to the county treasurer.'
