STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Making it Unlawful for Depositing Sawdust in the
Limits of the Highway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner, operator,
2 manager or employee of any mill used in the sawing of
3 lumber to establish, locate or use the same within such
4 proximity to any way of the state as to allow the sawdust
5 therefrom to blow into such highway.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars or more
3 than fifty dollars for each offense.
