STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary and Clerk Hire of the Register
of Probate in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirty-nine of chapter one hundred 2 and seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby 3 further amended, by striking out in line six after the word 4 "Aroostook" the words, "fifteen hundred dollars" and in- 5 serting in place the words 'twenty-five hundred dollars,' 6 so that said line as amended shall read as follows:

'Aroostook, twenty-five hundred dollars.'

Sect. 2. Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and 2 seventeen of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby

3 further amended, by striking out in line four of paragraph
4 three of said section the words "one thousand dollars" and
5 inserting in place thereof, the words 'fifteen hundred and
6 sixty dollars,' so that said paragraph of said section, so far
7 as it relates to the amount allowed for clerk hire in the
8 office of the register of probate in Aroostook county, as
9 amended, shall read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of the register of probate, fifteen
2 hundred and sixty dollars.'
