STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Time and Place of Holding the Commissioners' Court in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter eighty-three of the revised statutes,

as amended by chapter fifty-four of the public laws of nine
teen hundred and twenty-seven is hereby further amended

by striking out the twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth, thirtieth

and thirty-first lines of said section, as amended by said

chapter fifty-four of the public laws of nineteen hundred

and twenty-seven, and inserting in place thereof the words:

8 'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of May and 9 October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held each 10 month on the second Tuesday of January at Saco and on 11 the first Tuesday of all other months at Alfred,' so that said 12 section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of May and 2 October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held each 3 month, on the second Tuesday of January at Saco and on 4 the first Tuesday of all other months at Alfred.'
