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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, in Favor of H. E. Houdlette, Administrator of  
the Estate of Benjamin Owen Emmons, Late of Richmond,  
County of Sagadahoc, State of Maine, Deceased.

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Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500) to be paid to  
3 H. E. Houdlette, administrator of the estate of Benjamin  
4 Owen Emmons, late of Richmond, county of Sagadahoc,  
5 state of Maine, deceased, for the exclusive benefit of the  
6 widow and minor children of the said Benjamin Owen  
7 Emmons in the following proportions, to wit: Yvonne  
8 Emmons, widow, one-third; Donald Emmons, Bertha Em-

9 mons, Chester I. Emmons, Venise F. Emmons and William  
10 E. Emmons, minor children, two-fifteenths each, the same  
11 being a reimbursement for moneys disbursed, and liabilities  
12 incurred, by the said Benjamin Owen Emmons, the husband  
13 and father in his lifetime while engaged in his duty as  
14 ferryman across the Kennebec river between Richmond,  
15 Sagadahoc county, and Dresden, Lincoln county, under  
16 license from the county commissioners of Sagadahoc county.  
17 Said amount to be paid from any funds available.
