STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Establishment of Residence for Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

For purposes of voting, office-holding, or serving on jury,

husband and wife may be deemed each to have a separate

residence; such residence to be determined as in the case

of other persons.
