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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, to Compensate Edward J. Carroll and Alice Janet  
Carroll.

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Resolved: That the state of Maine pay to Edward J. Carroll and Alice Janet Carroll of Lewiston, the sum of four hundred eighty-six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$486.75) to compensate them for expenses incurred by reason of Alice Janet Carroll having been shot by a member of the state militia on the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred twenty-six, at South Paris. Said sum to be paid from the adjutant general's department funds.
