IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for the Expenses of the Contest Over the Election as Representative to the Legislature from the Towns of Dixfield, Hebron, Hartford, Sumner, Buckfield and Canton.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the

- 2 sum of four hundred seventy dollars and thirty-four cents,
- 3 (\$470.34), to be paid to the persons, and in the amounts,
- 4 named in the following schedule, from the appropriation
- 5 for contingent expenses of the eighty-fourth legislature:

To Rollin N. Stetson, of Bethel, for disbursements and 2 expenses and counsel fees incurred by him in the contested

- 3 election case as representative to the legislature from the
- 4 Igislative district of Dixfield, Hebron, Hartford, Sumner,
- 5 Buckfield and Canton, in the eighty-fourth legislature, the
- 6 sum of two hundred sixty-four dollars and eighty-four
- 7 cents (\$264.84.)

To Oscar E. Turner, of Hartford, for disbursements and

- 2 expenses and counsel fees incurred by him in the contested
- 3 election case as representative to the legislature from the
- 4 legislative district of Dixfield, Hebron, Hartford, Sumner,
- 5 Buckfield and Canton, in the eighty-fourth legislature, the
- 6 sum of two hundred five dollars and fifty cents (\$205.50.)
