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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE**

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**AN ACT to Provide a Bounty on Seals.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A bounty of one dollar for each and every  
2 seal killed in the waters of this state shall be paid by the  
3 treasurer of the town in which such seal is killed, to the  
4 person exhibiting to said treasurer the whole head of such  
5 seal within thirty days after said seal was killed. Such  
6 treasurer shall destroy it, and shall then proceed as in chap-  
7 ter two hundred forty-nine of the public laws of nineteen  
8 hundred twenty-seven. The certificates shall be in substan-  
9 tially the same form as provided under said chapter two

10 hundred forty-nine of the public laws of nineteen hundred  
11 twenty-seven, with such changes therein as may be neces-  
12 sary to comply with this act.

Sect. 2. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions  
2 of this act there is hereby appropriated the sum of five  
3 thousand dollars for each of the years nineteen hundred  
4 and twenty-nine and nineteen hundred and thirty.
