STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of the Outlet of Lake Messalonskee, in the Town of Oakland, in the County of Kennebec.

Resolved: That the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00)

- 2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from
- 3 the appropriation for the maintenance of the department
- 4 of inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the com-
- 5 missioner of inland fisheries and game, to aid in screening
- 6 Messalonskee lake, at the outlet, in the town of Oakland.
- 7 Provided, however, that said appropriation for the erection
- 8 of said screen shall not be available until some responsible

9 corporation or incorporated fish and game club, or the town 10 in which said outlet is located, or some other town in the II county of Kennebec, in which said waters are situated, shall 12 have in legal town meeting, and having an article in the 13 warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote 14 of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of 15 said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all 16 debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent 17 the free running of water through the same. And provided 18 further that said appropriation shall not be available until 19 the citizens of the county in which said lake is situated shall 20 have paid into the state treasury the balance found neces-21 sary by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game to 22 erect said screen. And provided, further, that if the actual 23 cost of said screen provided for in this resolve is less than 24 the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall be liable 25 for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any part of 26 said appropriation not expended in the year nineteen hun-27 dred and twenty-nine shall be available during the year 28 nineteen hundred and thirty.
