STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of
the Outlet of Worthley Pond, in Peru, in Oxford County.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars
2 be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the appro-
3 piation for the maintenance of the department of inland
4 fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner of
5 inland fisheries and game, to aid in screening Worthley
6 pond, at the outlet, in Peru, in Oxford county. Provided,
7 however, that said appropriation for the erection of said
8 screen shall not be available until some responsible corpo-
9 ration or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in

10 which said outlet is located, or some other town in the
11 county of Oxford, in which said waters are situated, shall
12 have in legal town meeting, and having an article in the
13 warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote
14 of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of
15 said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all de-
16 bris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent
17 the free running of water through the same. And pro-
18 vided further that said appropriation shall not be available
19 until the citizens of the county in which said pond is situ-
20 ated shall have paid into the state treasury the balance
21 found necessary by the commissioner of inland fisheries and
22 game to erect said screen. And provided, further, that if
23 the actual cost of said screen provided for in this resolve
24 is less than the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall
25 be liable for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any
26 part of said appropriation not expended in the year nine-
27 teen hundred and twenty-nine shall be available during the
28 year nineteen hundred and thirty.
