STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of
the Outlet of Wytopitlock Lake, in Glenwood, and in
Township 2, Range 4, in the County of Aroostook.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred and fifty (\$150.00)
2 dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the
3 appropriation for the maintenance of the department of
4 inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the com-
5 missioner of inland fisheries and game, to aid in screen-
6 ing Wytopitlock Lake, at the outlet, in Glenwood, and in
7 township two, range four, in the county of Aroostook.

8 Provided, however, that said appropriation for the erection
9 of said screen shall not be available until some responsible
10 corporation or incorporated fish and game club, or the
11 town in which said outlet is located, or some other town
12 in the county of Aroostook, in which said waters are sit-
13 uated, shall have in legal town meeting, and having an
14 article in the warrant for said town meeting for that pur-
15 pose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for
16 the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks,
17 leaves and all debris so that the same will not become
18 clogged and prevent the free running of water through
19 the same. And provided, further, that said appropriation
20 shall not be available until the citizens of the county in
21 which said lake is situated shall have paid into the state
22 treasury the balance found necessary by the commissioner
23 of inland fisheries and game to erect said screen. And pro-
24 vided, further, that if the actual cost of said screen pro-
25 vided for in this resolve is less than the amount appro-
26 priated therefor, the state shall be liable for only one-half
27 of the cost of such screen. Any part of said appropria-
28 tion not expended in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-
29 nine shall be available during the year nineteen hundred
30 and thirty.
