STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of the Outlet of Lovejoy Pond, in the Town of Albion, in the County of Kennebec.

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars 2 be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the appro3 priation for the maintenance of the department of inland 4 fisheries and game, to be expended by the commissioner 5 of inland fisheries and game, to aid in screening the out6 let of Lovejoy pond, in the town of Albion, in the county 7 of Kennebec. Provided, however, that said appropriation8 for the erection of said screen shall not be available until

9 some responsible corporation or incorporated fish and game 10 club, or the town in which said outlet is located, or some 11 other town in the county of Kennebec, in which said waters 12 are situated, shall have in legal town meeting, and having an 13 article in the warrant for said town meeting for that pur-14 pose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the 15 keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves 16 and all debris so that the same will not become clogged 17 and prevent the free running of water through the same. 18 And provided, further, that said appropriation shall not 19 be available until the citizens of the county in which said 20 pond is situated shall have paid into the state treasury the 21 balance found necessary by the commissioner of inland 22 fisheries and game to erect said screen. And provided, 23 further, that if the actual cost of said screen provided for 24 in this resolve is less than the amount appropriated therefor, 25 the state shall be liable for only one-half of the cost of 26 such screen. Any part of said appropriation not expended 27 in the year nineteen hundred and twenty-nine shall be avail-28 able during the year nineteen hundred and thirty.
