RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of  
the Outlet of Pierce's Pond, in the Town of Penobscot, in  
the County of Hancock.

---

Resolved: That the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) dol-  
2 lars be and hereby is appropriated, to be taken from the  
3 appropriation for the maintenance of the department of  
4 inland fisheries and game, to be expended by the commis-  
5 sioner of inland fisheries and game, to aid in screening the  
6 outlet of Pierce's pond, in the town of Penobscot, in the  
7 county of Hancock. Provided, however, that said appro-  
8 priation for the erection of said screen shall not be available  
9 until some responsible corporation or incorporated fish and

10 game club, or the town in which said outlet is located, or  
11 some other town in the county of Hancock, in which said  
12 waters are situated, shall have in legal town meeting, and  
13 having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for  
14 that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability  
15 for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks,  
16 leaves and all debris so that the same will not become clogged  
17 and prevent the free running of water through the same.  
18 And provided, further, that said appropriation shall not be  
19 available until the citizens of the county in which said pond  
20 is situated shall have paid into the state treasury the balance  
21 found necessary by the commissioner of inland fisheries and  
22 game to erect said screen. And provided, further, that if  
23 the actual cost of said screen provided for in this resolve  
24 is less than the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall  
25 be liable for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any  
26 part of said appropriation not expended in the year nine-  
27 teen hundred and twenty-nine shall be available during the  
28 year nineteen hundred and thirty.
