STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Maintaining a Feeding Station, or Rearing Pools for Fish at Liberty, in the County of Waldo.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred dollars for the 2 years nineteen hundred and twenty-nine and nineteen hun-3 dred and thirty annually be, and hereby is, appropriated, 4 out of the general fund for the maintenance and work of 5 the department of inland fisheries and game for the pur-6 pose of aiding in maintaining a feeding station for fish at 7 a suitable point at Liberty, in Waldo county, said money 8 hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of 9 the commissioner of inland fisheries and game for the 10 propagation of fish for distribution in said Waldo county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Liberty's fish and game association have erected a station at their own expense amounting to five hundred dollars. About fifteen pools were screened to be stocked from this station. Has a capacity of twenty thousand fish per year.
