STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Amusements on Memorial Day.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred sixteen of the public
2 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby amended by
3 adding in the first line after the word "day" the words
4 'before three-thirty o'clock in the afternoon,' so that said
5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. Whoever on Memorial day before three-thirty
2 o'clock in the afternoon engages in any public outdoor game
3 or sport where an admission is charged or collection is
4 taken shall be punished by a fine not exceeding twenty-five
5 dollars or imprisonment not exceeding ten days, or by both

6 such fine and imprisonment. Judges of municipal and po-
7 lice courts and trial justices shall have jurisdiction of all
8 offenses under this act.
