IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Naming the Bridge at Bath.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:That the bridge across the Kennebec river between the city2 of Bath and the town of Woolwich, is hereby designated3 and shall be forever known as the Carlton Bridge.
