STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Provide for the Completion of the Raised Road

Between Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to complete the con-3 struction of a raised road across the bar between the islands 4 of Deer Isle and Little Deer Isle in said county of Han-5 cock, as authorized by chapter one hundred and twelve of 6 the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and twen-7 ty-seven; said sum to be expended under the direction of 8 the state highway department. This resolve is on condition 9 that the town raise five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to be

10 expended on the said raised road in the same year as the
11 state's appropriation. Said funds to be taken from the
12 highway construction fund.
