STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Eminent Domain for Ferries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Corporations organized for the purpose of owning, controlling, operating or managing any steam ferry boat regularly
engaged in the transportation of persons or property for
compensation upon tidal waters over regular routes between
points within this state, and under the jurisdiction of the
public utilities commission, are hereby authorized and empowered to take and hold, as for public uses, such lands
and easements as may be necessary for the proper location
of any ferry wings or other structures designed and used
in such transportation in the same manner as set forth in

sections eleven to twenty-two, both inclusive, of chapter iz sixty-one of the revised statutes and amendments thereto, is provided however that such taking shall be approved, and it the public exigency determined by decree of the municipal officers of the city or town in which such land and easements are located, by the county commissioners of the country ty, and by the public utilities commission.
