STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Pollution of the Waters of Carleton
Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter three hundred and sixty of the
2 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and five is
3 hereby amended by striking out all of said section and in-
4 serting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 5. No person shall use any boat on said pond, or
2 fish therein, or harvest ice therefrom, or in any way poison,
3 defile or corrupt the waters thereof, provided, however,
4 that nothing herein shall prevent the necessary uses of said
5 pond by the Augusta Water District. Whosoever violates

6 this section shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one
7 hundred dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding six
8 months.'
