STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a Memorial for William Pitt Fessenden.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated, the 2 sum of five thousand dollars for the erection of a statue 3 in the city of Portland for a memorial for William Pitt 4 Fessenden, formerly United States Senator, providing an 5 equal amount shall be raised by private contributions, the 6 entire sum to be expended under the direction of the gov-7 ernor and council and the committee to be appointed by the 8 city council of Portland; the aforesaid appropriation shall 9 not lapse but shall continue until the erection of said statue.
