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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Twelve of Chapter Twenty-five of the Revised Statutes Relative to the Use of Bond Issue Funds in Compact Portions of Certain Towns.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twelve of chapter twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sect. 12. The commission shall determine the compact portions of towns of more than twenty-five hundred inhabitants, and all state highways within such compact portions shall be maintained in good repair by the town wherein the same are located at the expense of the town, and whenever

6 any town shall neglect so to maintain within fourteen days  
7 after notice given its municipal officers by the commission,  
8 the commission may proceed to make necessary repairs to  
9 such way, which shall be paid for by the state and the cost  
10 thereof shall be collected and paid as provided in section  
11 twenty-four; and the amounts so collected from such towns  
12 shall be added to the fund for maintenance and adminis-  
13 tration. The commission may in respect thereto grant such  
14 towns such financial assistance as it deems advisable.
