STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, In Favor of the Bangor State Hospital.

WHEREAS, the construction of a new wing of the Bangor State Hospital has been completed and ready for occupancy and there is available no money for the maintenance and labor required when it is filled with patients, and there is no source of revenue and no provision of law by which money can be transferred from one State Hospital to another, it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and in the judgment of this legislature these facts constitute an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, now therefore be it

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for
2 the maintenance and personal services of the new wing of
3 the Bangor State Hospital and the patients therein, the sum
4 of fifteen thousand dollars.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble this resolve
2 shall take effect when approved.
