IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, In Favor of Memorial at Thomaston, Maine, for Major General Henry Knox.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, 2 the sum of (\$32,000) thirty-two thousand dollars for the 3 purchase of a site and construction of a building at Thomas-4 ton, Maine, for a memorial for Major General Henry Knox, 5 said sum to be expended, along with other funds privately 6 raised for the purpose, by the Knox Memorial Association 7 of said Thomaston, under the direction of the Governor and 8 Council.
