STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Highmoor Farm, in the Town of Monmouth.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of five thousand dollars for the year from July first, 3 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirtieth, nine-4 teen hundred and thirty, and five thousand dollars for the 5 year from July first, nineteen hundred and thirty, to June 6 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, for the main-7 tenance of Highmoor Farm, in the town of Monmouth. 8 Said sum to be expended under the direction of the Maine 9 agricultural experiment station.
