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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Fred F. Harris  
of Lewiston.

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Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be,  
2 and hereby is, granted to Fred F. Harris, of Lewiston, to  
3 be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers  
4 and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first,  
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and continue until other-  
6 wise provided by the legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fred F. Harris is an honorably discharged veteran of the Spanish-American War. His health is very poor and his earnings are small. He has a large family to support, including two grandchildren who have no other means of support, and the amount provided by this resolve, with his earnings and his government pension, will be barely enough to enable him to procure a livelihood for himself and his dependents.
