# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-nine of Chapter Sixtyseven of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Fees to be Paid by Executor or Administrator.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-nine of chapter sixty-seven of the revised

- 2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifty
- 3 cents" in the second, third and fifth lines thereof, and
- 4 substituting in place thereof, the words, 'one dollar,' so
- 5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 39. Fees to be paid by executor or administrator.

- 2 R. S. c. 65, 22. For making and certifying to the register
- 3 of deeds copies of devises of real estate, the register of

4 probate shall receive one dollar for each copy so certified,
5 and the register of deeds one dollar for entering and record6 ing the same, said sums to be paid by the executor or ad7 ministrator when said will is proved, to the register of pro8 bate, who shall pay one dollar to the register of deeds at
9 the time said certified copy in furnished to him; and the
10 executor or administrator shall charge said sums in his
11 account.'
