STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Sheriffs and their Deputies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph twenty-three of section five of
2 chapter one hundred eighteen of the revised statutes, as
3 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out in the
4 second line thereof the word "four" and inserting the word
5 "five," so that said section as amended will read as fol-
6 lows:

Every deputy sheriff, while performing special duties
2 under the order of the sheriff shall receive for such services
3 five dollars a day, together with necessary, incidental
4 expenses, to be paid from the county treasury, the bills for

5 which shall be audited as provided in section one, chapter
6 one hundred and thirty-eight of the revised statutes.'
