AN ACT to Authorize the Town of South Bristol to Raise Money for the Purpose of Helping Keep in Repair the Old Cemeteries in Said Town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of South Bristol, a municipal 2 corporation in the county of Lincoln, are hereby authorized

- 3 to raise money, under an appropriate article in the town
- 4 warrant, to help keep in good repair and condition all monu-
- 5 ments, headstones, markers and graves in any or all of the
- 6 cemeteries of said town and also to keep all bushes and
- 7 grass cut and the trees and shrubs properly trimmed. The

8 sums so raised may be expended by the said town or its 9 servants or agents or by a committee consisting of citizens 10 thereof and any church organization or society interested in 11 keeping such burying ground in proper condition and repair.
