IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of South Bristol to Raise  
Money for the Purpose of Helping Keep in Repair the Old  
Cemeteries in Said Town.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of South Bristol, a municipal  
2 corporation in the county of Lincoln, are hereby authorized  
3 to raise money, under an appropriate article in the town  
4 warrant, to help keep in good repair and condition all monu-  
5 ments, headstones, markers and graves in any or all of the  
6 cemeteries of said town and also to keep all bushes and  
7 grass cut and the trees and shrubs properly trimmed. The

8 sums so raised may be expended by the said town or its  
9 servants or agents or by a committee consisting of citizens  
10 thereof and any church organization or society interested in  
11 keeping such burying ground in proper condition and repair.
