STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Section Fifty-two of Chapter Eighty-two
of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Legal Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-two of chapter eighty-two of the revised
2 statutes, as amended by chapter fifty of the public laws of
3 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby amended by
4 inserting after the words "presidential electors" in the sec-
5 ond line, the words 'Washington's birthday, February
6 twenty-second,' so that said section, as amended, shall read
7 as follows:

'Sect. 52. No court shall be held on Sunday, or any day

2 designated for the annual thanksgiving, or for the choice
3 of presidential electors, Washington's birthday, February
4 twenty-second, the nineteenth day of April, the thirtieth
5 day of May, the fourth day of July, the first Monday of
6 September, the day of the state election, Armistice Day,
7 November eleventh, or on Christmas day; and when the
8 time fixed for a term of said court falls on either of said
9 days, it shall stand adjourned until the next day, which
10 shall be deemed the first day of the term for all purposes.'
