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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Fifty of Chapter One Hundred and Seventeen of the Revised Statutes Relating to Board of Registration in Optometry.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the  
2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word  
3 "five," in the third line thereof and inserting in place there-  
4 of the word 'ten,' so that said section, as amended, shall  
5 read as follows:

'Sect. 50. The members of the board of registration and  
2 examination in optometry shall each receive ten dollars for  
3 each day actually engaged in the duties of his office, and

4 actual expenses incurred in attending the meeting of the  
5 board. The secretary shall be reimbursed for all necessary  
6 expenses incurred while discharging his duties to the board  
7 at his home. All moneys received over and above said per  
8 diem allowance and expenses as above provided, shall be  
9 held by the treasurer as a special fund for meeting the ex-  
10 penditures of said board and carrying out the provisions  
11 of sections forty-one to fifty-five, both inclusive, of chapter  
12 eighteen.'
