AN ACT Additional to Chapter 142 of the Revised Statutes  
Permitting the Warden of the State Prison to credit to  
each Inmate, Under Certain Conditions, a Percentage of  
the Inmate's Earnings.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Each inmate on completing his daily task as  
2 approved by the warden, in a satisfactory manner, may have  
3 placed to his credit with the warden an amount not to ex-  
4 ceed 15% of the amount earned for the state by that work,  
5 50% of the amount so credited to be retained by the war-  
6 den, in the case of indeterminate sentences, until such time  
7 as the inmate is released from prison.
