STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Exempt Certain Non-resident Motor Vehicles from Registration While in the State Exclusively for Display or Demonstration Purposes; Also Non-resident Passenger Busses Chartered and Used Exclusively for Private Conveyance of Non-residents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The following vehicles, owned and operated

by non-residents, which would be otherwise required by

statute to pay a registration fee, shall if duly registered in

the state of their ownership, be exempt from registration

in this state for a period of thirty days while operated in

this state under the conditions and limitations hereinafter

provided:

- Any motor truck, tractor or trailer brought into the
 state and used exclusively herein for display purposes in
 agricultural and industrial fairs and motor vehicle exhi bitions.
- Any apparatus and trucks conveying apparatus brought
 into the state and while used herein exclusively for exhi bition or demonstrations at firemen's musters.
- 3. Any passenger bus bringing into the state as a single 2 organized group or party persons for whose exclusive use 3 such bus has been chartered and is so used, and which is 4 chartered and intended to be used solely as a continuous 5 means of conveyance for such group of persons while they 6 are touring in the state.
- Sect. 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to author2 ize the operation of any vehicle herein described in any
 3 manner contrary to the provisions of statute relating to the
 4 operation of other similar vehicles upon ways and bridges
 5 of this state, except as herein modified. Whoever violates
 6 or fails to comply with the provisions of this act shall be
 7 subject to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or im8 prisonment not exceeding ninety days or both, and any
 9 vehicle used in violation hereof shall be subject to the fees
 10 provided for registration of like vehicles which are not
 11 exempted from the provisions of this act.
