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STATE OF MAINE

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RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry A. Day, of Bangor.

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Resolved: That there be and hereby is, appropriated the  
2 sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars, to be paid  
3 Henry A. Day, of Bangor, Maine, to reimburse him for  
4 losses sustained in the construction of a piece of road in  
5 the town of Orono, Maine.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Henry A. Day, of Bangor, Maine, took a contract to build the roadbed of a road in the town of Orono, Maine, the contract being with the Portland Construction Co. Three miles of this roadbed was built by him. After building same, water pipes burst, and other circumstances beyond Mr. Day's control caused certain portions of said roadbed to be washed out, etc., so that he was forced, at a great loss, to rebuild same. To add to all this, the Portland Construction Co. went into bankruptcy.
