# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Making It Lawful to Kill Foxes and Skunks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:Section 1. It shall be lawful at any time to hunt, trap, kill,2 pursue or catch, any fox or skunk and to have such fox or3 skunk or any part thereof in possession.

Sect. 2. Section forty-seven of chapter thirty-three of the 2 revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed.
