AN ACT Making It Lawful to Kill Foxes and Skunks.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful at any time to hunt, trap, kill,  
2 pursue or catch, any fox or skunk and to have such fox or  
3 skunk or any part thereof in possession.

Sect. 2. Section forty-seven of chapter thirty-three of the  
2 revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed.
