STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Maine Central Institute.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter seventeen of the private and special
2 laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six, as amend-
3 ed, by section two of chapter five hundred one of the
4 private and special laws of one thousand eight hundred and
5 eighty-nine, is hereby amended by striking out the entire
6 section two as amended and by inserting the following so
7 that said section two shall read as follows:

‘Sect. 2. The said board of trustees shall be divided into
2 five classes of not more than five persons each. The term
3 of office of the first class shall expire at the time of the

4 annual meeting of said board of trustees in the year nine-
5 teen hundred and thirty-one, the term of office of the second
6 class shall expire at the time of the annual meeting of said
7 board of trustees in the year nineteen hundred thirty-two,
8 the term of office of the third class shall expire at the time
9 of the annual meeting of said board of trustees in the year
10 nineteen hundred and thirty-three, the term of office of the
11 fourth class shall expire at the time of the annual meeting
12 of said board of trustees in the year nineteen hundred and
13 thirty-four and the term of office of the fifth class shall
14 expire at the time of the annual meeting of said board of
15 trustees in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-five, and
16 beginning at the time of the annual meeting of the board
17 of trustees in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, five
18 persons shall annually be chosen as members of said board
19 of trustees to hold office for the term of five years. The
20 said five classes shall be elected by the trustees at the annual
21 meeting of the trustees of Maine Central Institute in nine-
22 teen hundred and thirty.
