STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of an Assistant County Attorney for the County of Penobscot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county attorney of the county of Penobscot is hereby 2 authorized to appoint a member of Penobscot bar as an 3 assistant; said assistant shall take the oath prescribed for 4 county attorneys; shall assist the county attorney in the 5 ordinary duties of his office, in the drawing of indictments, 6 and in the hearing of complaints before the grand jury, and 7 the preparation and trial of criminal causes. He shall, when 8 directed by the county attorney act as counsel for the state

9 in the trial of complaints, before judges of municipal courts 10 and trial justices. The salary of said assistant shall be 11 twelve hundred dollars, payable in the same manner as that 12 of county attorneys and shall hold his office during incum-13 bency in office of the county attorney by whom he is ap-14 pointed, and at the pleasure of said county attorney. But 15 for cause said assistant may be removed from office in the 16 manner now prescribed by law for removal of county at-17 torneys.
