### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, for the General Distribution of Data Concerning the Resources of the State.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred and five thousand, four hundred and 3 forty dollars for the fiscal year from July one, nineteen 4 hundred and twenty-nine, to June thirty, nineteen hundred 5 and thirty, and the sum of one hundred and five thousand 6 four hundred and forty dollars for the fiscal year from 7 July one, nineteen hundred and thirty, to June thirty, nine-8 teen hundred and thirty-one, for the purpose of carrying 9 out and continuing the provisions of chapter one hundred 10 sixty-two of the resolves of nineteen hundred twenty-seven.

11 for the collection, compilation, publication, general distribu-12 tion and advertising of data relative to the state, and the 13 general administration of the purposes of said chapter, same 14 to be expended by the Maine Development Commission, 15 established by said chapter.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine Development Commission was created by Chapter 162 of the Resolves of 1927 for the purpose of collecting, compiling and publishing data relative to the state. The budget committee after hearing the report of this commission recommends the appropriation of \$105,440 for each of the two succeeding fiscal years.
