STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Central Maine Sanatorium for the Laying of a Six Inch Water Main from the County Highway to the Sanatorium Buildings.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, the water main hereinafter mentioned can be built to much better advantage to the state if the contract therefor is let earlier in the season and the work begun as soon as possible, and

Whereas, money for such building cannot be used until the funds provided by this resolve become available and loss and inconvenience will result if such work is not started early in the season, and Whereas, the buildings of the Central Maine Sanatorium are not now adequately supplied with water for protection in case of fire, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section sixteen of article thirty-one of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, now therefore be it

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for 2 the Central Maine Sanatorium the sum of four thousand 3 five hundred dollars for the laying of a six inch water main 4 from the county highway to the sanatorium buildings, said 5 sum to be available during the fiscal year from July first, 6 nineteen hundred twenty-nine to June thirtieth, nineteen 7 hundred thirty.

Emergency Clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 2 preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.
