STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Portland Water
District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Portland Water District shall pay taxes on all land,
2 buildings, improvements, dams, gate-houses, structures, pipe-
3 lines, and all property real or personal under its control,
4 within the town of Standish at the same rate that other
5 taxable property within said town of Standish is taxed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Portland Water District takes water from Sebago Lake to supply the district, but renders no service to the residents of Standish. In the hope of giving protection to the purity of the water, the district has acquired, by right of eminent domain and otherwise, considerable land and numerous buildings. This act will partially recompense the town for the loss of income.
