STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Provide a Commission for Investigating the
Feasibility of a Bridge across the Penobscot River near
Bucksport.

Resolved: That the governor, by and with the consent
2 of the council, be and hereby is authorized and empowered
3 to appoint a commission consisting of seven members, whose
4 duty it shall be to investigate the feasibility of constructing
5 a bridge with approaches thereto across the Penobscot river
6 from a convenient point in the town of Bucksport or the
7 town of Verona, to a convenient point in the town of Pros-
8 pect, together with appropriate fills, approaches and appur-
9 tenant structures; to recommend the most practical location

10 for such bridge and the most advisable building material,
11 dimensions, size and style for such bridge; to estimate the
12 cost thereof; and to make recommendations regarding the
13 method of financing such bridge. Said commission is au-
14 thorized to employ engineers, assistants and clerks and are
15 to report to the governor and council as soon as they have
16 completed their investigation and formulated their recom-
17 mendations by bill or otherwise. The governor shall cause
18 the report and recommendations of the said commission to
19 be printed and distributed at the state's expense, at least
20 one copy of such report to be mailed to each member of
21 the present legislature at their proper residence and to each
22 member of the next legislature of this state in case said
23 report and recommendations are not submitted until sub-
24 sequent to the election of the next legislature. Such ex-
25 pense as may be incurred by said commission in their in-
26 vestigation and report shall be paid out of any money in the
27 treasury not otherwise appropriated.
