# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Registration of Non-resident Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The second paragraph of section thirty-four of the public

- 2 laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, as amended, is here-
- 3 by further amended by adding in the fourth line thereof
- 4 after the word "one" the words 'and one-half,' so that said
- 5 paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Paragraph 2. But no vehicle owned or operated by a non-

- 2 resident shall be operated on the public ways of this state
- 3 as a vehicle engaged in the business of livery or for hire,
- 4 or as a jitney, within this state, and no motor truck or trail-
- 5 er having a rated carrying capacity of more than one and

6 one-half ton and owned or operated by a non-resident, shall 7 be operated on the highways of this state, except and until 8 it has been registered under the laws of this state and made 9 to comply with the by-laws and ordinances of municipalito ties wherein it is operated, in the same manner as may be 11 required of like vehicles owned, operated and registered in 12 this state, and all operators of the same shall be licensed in 13 like manner as residents of this state are required to be li-
